

Planting to moisture






Germinate weeds




Cultivate (rolling cultivator)

Second cultivation (rolling cultivator reforms bed)

Recommendations:

- 1) Create "production blocks" to facilitate rotations
- 2) Systematize production blocks
 - a) Incorporate cover crop
 - b) Form beds soon after incorporation
 - c) Pre-irrigate (overhead) unless rainfall is adequate
 - d) Work beds with rolling cultivator after weed emergence
 - e) Shape beds and plant (direct sow or transplant)
 - f) Overhead irrigate "as needed" to establish strong roots on small seeded and transplanted crops
 - g) Dry down block and cultivate and hand hoe
 - h) Switch from overhead to drip to finish off crops
 - i) Flail mow and undercut beds post harvest to knock down weed seed heads and halt weed growth
 - j) recycle beds or prep ground for cover crop
