The Alameda County Resource Conservation District is announcing the departure of their long-time Chief Executive Officer, Katherine Boxer. After 11 years, Katherine is leaving the District to pursue new ventures.

During Katherine's tenure at the District she developed and oversaw multiple new programs. Ms. Boxer's accomplishments include doubling the District's annual revenue, adding several new staff positions, creating Bylaws, initiating wildlife research that was funded by the Altamont Landfill Open Space Committee and culminated in receiving a 7.1 million dollar grant from the CA Wildlife Conservation Board to plan and ultimately construct wildlife crossings on Interstates 580, 680 and Highway 84. The crossings will connect with land corridors for wildlife to range over their habitat.
